2020-2021 Tuition and Fees Details

Tuition and Fees

(the following are per student costs)

Yearly for Grades K-6	\$6,250
Yearly for Grades 7-12	\$6,750
Academic Materials Fee*	\$50
Athletics Fee**	\$100

* This will NOT cover literature/humanities books.

**Covers all mandatory PE programs. Does NOT include ski program.

Payment Schedule/Options

- \$100 of yearly fee (per student) due along with Tuition Contract by April 24, 2020
- Academic Materials and Athletics Fees due by August 1, 2020
- Remainder of yearly can be paid by one of the following options:
 - Full payment due August 15, 2020
 - Half payments due August 15, 2020 and January 15, 2021
 - 8 monthly payments due 1st of every month from August 1, 2020 to March 1, 2021
 - 10 monthly payments due 1st of every month from July 1, 2020 to April 1, 2021
 - Other payment schedules can be arranged with the Executive Director as needed.

Volunteer Hours

Each family is required to do 10 hours of volunteer time per quarter. At the end of each quarter, hours not completed will be charged at \$40/hour.

Families may opt out of volunteer hours (if they are not receiving financial aid) by paying \$1,200 by August 1, 2020 or splitting this payment over the 8 or 10 month payments (\$150 or \$120 or \$100 per month respectively).

Note: Fundraising and donations will be handled separately from volunteer hours.

Application Deadlines

Returning Families: Re-enrollment forms are due no later than April 6. Returning families who choose not to re-enroll by April 6 will need to re-apply. Financial aid requests due with re-enrollment forms.

New Applicants: Guaranteed application deadline April 6, 2020. After April 6, applications will continue to be accepted on a rolling basis.

Financial Aid

Financial Aid is available by request. Requests must be made using the official NECA Financial Aid Request Form to be turned in with a sealed envelope holding a copy of your most recent tax return and a letter explaining your need. The request form does NOT go in the sealed envelope. The sealed envelope should say “Financial Aid Request” and your family name on it. An anonymous committee reviews the requests and makes recommendations accordingly to the Administration of the Academy.

New applicants and returning families should submit financial aid requests along with their application and by Monday, April 6, in which case offers will be sent out by May 4. After April 6, all requests will be done on a rolling basis and depend on how much funding is left for assistance.

Financial aid offers include family discounts (for multiple children enrolled), scholarship, and need-based aid. If significant aid is given due to need, the offer may include addition of volunteer hours or a fundraising requirement. Any questions on a financial aid offer can be brought to the Executive Director.

NH Children’s Scholarship Fund is another source of funds for new applicants, and they have a lot more funds at their disposal. They recommend applying as early as possible, so as soon as you choose to apply to NECA it would benefit to submit the pre-application.
